Help track participants' progress and assist the PD in communicating that progress to families.

Assist in developing, implementing and updating program policies and procedures and awards for participants.

Ensure all participants and coaches receive necessary First Tee equipment, apparel, nametags, etc.

Manage and coordinate with lead coaches/site coordinators all existing inventory of program gear and supplies.

As requested, communicate with parents/guardians via email, mail, text and telephone calls.

Provide opportunities to engage parents/guardians in their child's learning.
